WHO WE REACH**

RING newspapers reach 125,000 unique households in Rhode Island offering full coverage of the Providence DMA. The vast majority of our readers are homeowners. They are committed to their communities. They are educated, active participants in their towns and cities.

- 61% keep their community newspaper for at least 4 days

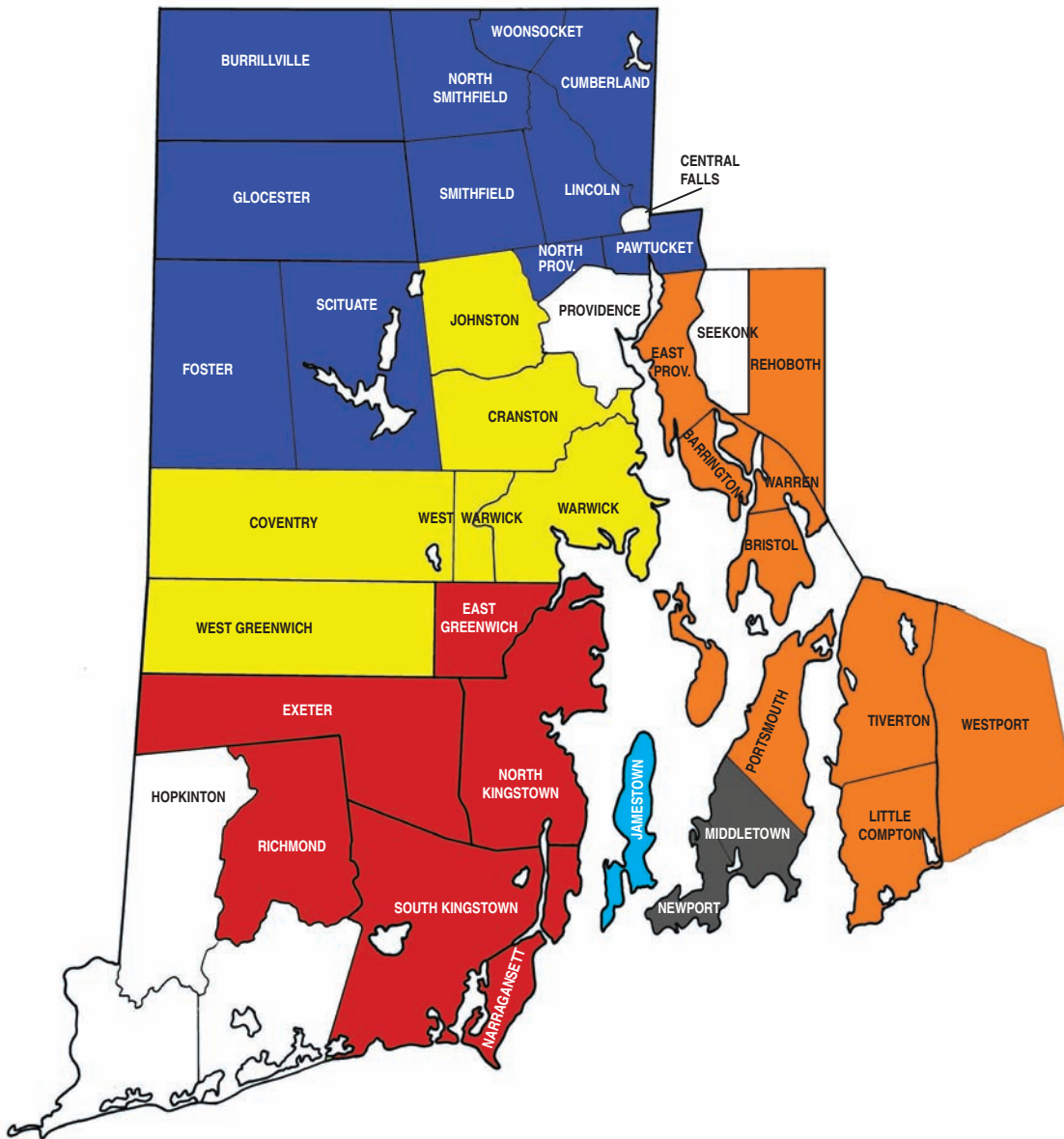
